

On 2 July 2021, the new Small Town Lottery Authorized Agent Corporation for Muntinlupa City, Great Mind Games and Amusement Corporation, held its first draw.

The STL AACs provided jobs for 244,417 sales representatives or *cobradores,* 19,047 sales supervisors or *cabos,* and 9,663 organic STL employees (Table 22).

As for commissions, the agency dispensed an estimated amount of Php5.66 billion to Lotto and Keno agents, and STL salesforce in 2021. Out of this amount, Php 1.35 billion was released to Lotto and Keno agents, and Php4.3 billion for STL *cobradores and cabos*.
