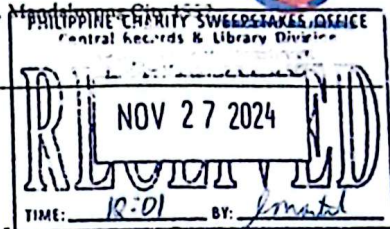

Constitution of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Committee

Pursuant to (1) GCG Memorandum Circular No. 2024-01 dated 18 June 2024 regarding the Enhanced Performance Evaluation System (PES) for the GOCC Sector requiring the integration of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) in the GOCC's Performance Scorecard and (2) Republic Act No. 9729 also known as Climate Change Act of 2009 requiring the integration of disaster risk reduction and management measures into policies and climate change adaptation plans, the DRRM Committee is hereby constituted:

The Committee has the following functions:

1. Develop and formulate policies, programs, plans and activities on disaster risk reduction and management aligned with the government's policies, and consistent with relevant DRRM laws and issuances;
2. Implement plans, programs and activities on DRRM including training, capacity building and direct intervention of the agency's climate change programs and plans;
3. Conduct public awareness campaigns on the effects of climate change and energy-saving solutions to mitigate these effects through educational and training programs; and

4. Recommend budgetary allocation on the implementation of DRRM plans, programs, and initiatives.

The GCG Memorandum Circular No. 2024-01 dated 28 June 2024, suggests that policies, plans, and programs may involve themes, as follows: operational continuity, infrastructure resilience, supply chain stability, service resilience, development resilience, and financial support. For this purpose, Technical Working Groups are further constituted to assist the DRRM Committee, as follows:
