All questions raised in today's Pre-Bid Conference shall be answered in writing, through a Supplemental Bid Bulletin (SBB), which shall be issued at least seven (7) calendar days before the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids on July 1, 2019 pursuant to Section 22.3, 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184.

The governing law for this Project will be Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act (GPRA) and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation.

The GPRA shall prescribe the necessary rules and regulations for the modernization, standardization and regulation of the procurement activities of the Government of the Philippines (GOP); including PCSO. 

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

(PCSO) LOTTERY SYSTEM (PLS) SBAC Contract No.

Dear AGM Aseo,

In reference to the Bidding Documents on the five years lease of the Philippines Charity Sweepstakes office (PCSO) Lottery System, and as a prospective bidder of the said infrastructure project, I would like to request your kind office to consider the following requests for changes on the Terms of Reference as itemized below:

Item 1)

In reference to Section 6.2, Special Conditions of Contract, sub-section II **Customized Lottery System**, paragraph 3.6 **WLA SCS**:

PCSO is improperly applying the WLA-SCS. The WLA SCS is not meant, designed, or intended to be applied to a "Lottery System". In fact it cannot be. The WLA SCS is designed to apply to an *organization*. The standard describes security management *processes*, *procedures*, and requirements of the *organization* itself, including the *organization*'s security and integrity management system, and not a particular "IT system" like a lottery system on an individual basis. As such it is not possible for a lottery system supplier to obtain WLA SCS certification on their lottery system product itself.



Furthermore, WLA-SCS certification can only be granted to WLA members, as since WLA is a private club with strict admission rules, the SBAC is illegally discriminating against bidders who are not members of this club. Therefore the requirement for the proposed Customized Lottery System to be WLA SCS certified should be removed (para 3.6).

Likewise, for all the same reasons stated above, it is also not appropriate for any gaming laboratory to apply the WLA SCS to a lottery system individually and for this reason para 3.6iii should also be removed. Furthermore, this sort of requirement whereby an independent lab issue a certification for WLA SCS for a lottery system is not a process or procedure that any prospective bidder would ever contemplate in the absence of this actual requirement in the bidding documents. As such the PCSO is inventing a new process or procedure for it's own needs, and announcing it in the bidding documents. A prospective bidder who wishes to fulfill this requirement would therefore need complete it prior to the submission of bids which is a timeline that is impossible to meet. As such, the requirement of para 3.66iii is one that is impossible for any bidder to achieve in the time allotted and for this additional reason should be removed.

Item 2)

Due to the complex nature of this procurement, the time and effort required for bidders to compile all the necessary documents and meet all requirements is very large. So that PCSO can obtain the highest number of qualified bidders, which is in the best interest of the PCSO and the government and people of the Philippines via the organizations you support, we respectfully request an extension of the bid submission date by the largest amount allowed by law for a large INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT such as this.
