Failure to enter into a joint venture in the event of a contract award shall be ground for the forfeiture of the bid security.



- The Data Center and Mirror Facilities that PCSO intends to procure by lease are data centers that are private/dedicated and NOT colocated;
- 2. Relative to the provision of resources such as modular office, call center agents cubicles, interior furnishings, etc., the workplace/s should be conducive and should foster maximum efficiency, productivity from the personnel;
- 3. The bidder must have installed at **THOUSAND** FOUR **SEVEN** least **HUNDRED FIFTY SIX (4,756) fixed** terminal units, that are active; in commercial operation and connected to a single gaming system through a telecommunications carrier, whether located within or outside the Philippines for the past ten (10) years, reckoned from date submission and receipt of bids;
- 4. As to the definition of similar contracts, it shall refer to the supply and delivery and installation of gaming terminals that are active, operational and connected to a single gaming system through a secured telecommunications carrier, whether located within or outside the Philippines, for the past ten (10) years, reckoned from the date of submission and receipt of bids;
- 5. Gaming System shall refer to the software application that manages the interaction between components such as gaming terminals, servers, network and security appliances through telecommunications carrier to generate a gaming transaction.



In the event that a separate secure location other than the PCSO main office premises where the Data Center should be housed was agreed upon, the location of the DCF shall have a five-meter buffer zone on both sides of an active fault per PHIVOLCS Regulations, Circulars, and Pronouncements.
